## Example #1: Importing a CSV to Create Tasks

### Purpose

- 1. Show how to create new records from a CSV file using Fusion
- 2. Use data from the CSV file to look up required information (job role ID)

## Example #1: Importing a CSV to Create Tasks

- Edit Excel or CSV file
- 2. Save as CSV file
  - Should open in a text editor as comma-separated values
  - Generally have a quotation text qualifier
  - 3. Upload File to Workfront
  - 4. Copy the Document ID from the URL
  - Add it to the Fusion scenario
  - 5. Create or navigate to a project and copy the Project ID from the URL
  - Add it to the Fusion scenario
  - 6. Run the Fusion scenario to add tasks

## Example #2: Importing a CSV to create parameter values

### Purpose

- 1. Show how to create form field values
- 2. Utilize custom API calls to search for and create uncommon records

### Example #2: Importing a CSV to create parameter values

- 1. Edit Excel or CSV file
- 2. Save as CSV file
  - Should open in a text editor as comma-separated values
  - Generally have a quotation text qualifier
  - 3. Upload File to Workfront
  - 4. Copy the Document ID from the URL
  - Add it to the Fusion scenario
  - 5. Create or navigate to a project and copy the Project ID from the URL
  - Add it to the Fusion scenario
  - 6. Create or locate the dropdown form field
    - Get the ID from the "Fields" area by adding "ID" to the view. Add the ID to the Fusion scenario.
  - 7. Run the Fusion scenario to add Parameter IDs



## Example #3: Exporting a CSV to a Workfront file

### Purpose

- 1. Start with a Workfront search to gather data from Workfront
- 2. Look up additional information with an additional search
- 3. Use a data structure for CSV columns
- 4. Export search-based data to a CSV file and upload it to Workfront

## Example #3: Exporting a CSV to a Workfront file

- 1. Create or navigate to a project and copy the Project ID from the URL
  - Add the ID to the Set Scenario Variables module
- 2. Create or navigate to a Portfolio and copy the Portfolio ID from the URL
  - Add the ID to the Set Scenario Variables module
  - 3. Add the CSV file name to the Set Scenario Variables module
  - 4. Run the scenario to export the project

### Demo: Using a request queue to import an emailed CSV file

#### Purpose

1. How can a request queue be utilized to import a regularly emailed CSV file?

#### How it works

- 1. Create a request queue
- 2. Enable Request Intake via Email
  - csv\_import\_bh@intake1.my.workfront.com
- 3. Set up a Fusion scenario to process incoming requests
  - New issue for the queue project ID
- 4. Get the incoming document attachment and process CSV records



## NEW! Fusion Template – Change Project Timeline when Task Completed Early

This template is designed to support organizations that follow a more flexible, "planas-you-go" approach rather than strict PMI-based methodology for Project Management.

- If your team struggles to maintain momentum because project timelines don't adjust dynamically, this solution is for you.
   Often, when tasks are completed ahead of schedule, it makes sense to accelerate the overall timeline — but manually updating dates can be tedious.
- This Fusion template automates that process.
   When a task is completed early, all dependent (successor) tasks are automatically rescheduled to start sooner, helping your team move faster and stay agile.


